They teach under the guidelines of the State of Illinois and North Shore School District 112. There are two teacher assistants in each classroom to help meet the needs of all our children.

We value the parent school partnership as we work together to meet the needs of your preschool child. Our goal is to provide appropriate activities through child initiated and teacher directed experiences. Children learn to think and problem solve through play in a language rich environment that encourages independence and responsibility. We focus on pre-academic skills as well as your child's social and emotional needs.

WHEN do our programs meet?

Programs meet five days a week. We follow the school district calendar.

We have two sessions daily:

Morning session 9:00 to 11:30 am

Afternoon session 12:15 to 2:45 pm
