Find a picture postcard in which you can place a photograph of yourself (head shot or full body). The finished product must make a visually-biting satirical comment about an aspect of your life, habits, style, or physical attributes. The postcard should be self-explanatory and need little to no verbal captioning.

What is satire?

***The formal definition is the “use of ridicule in exposing, denouncing, or deriding vice, folly, etc.”**

***A satirical comment often can be a single line, saying the opposite of what is intended and ridiculing a specific flaw or vice.**

***It is humor used to attack; many satirists want to change a current situation and they express their desire through mocking praise.**
