

THREE DOORS

A Values Study

Pretend you are standing in front of three closed doors. Now imagine that behind each is something from your life that you will describe as you open each door. This is an essay with an introduction, three body paragraphs, and a conclusion.

Behind door #1 is a past challenge; what is it and if you met and matched that challenge tell how you did it. If, on the other hand, you recognized it but are still trying to deal with that challenge, describe it and explain how you are dealing with it today.

Behind door #2 is a present opportunity; what is it and what will you do about it? What is both positive and negative about seizing that opportunity?

Behind door #3 is a future reward; what is it and how will it come about in your life? For what will you be rewarded?

Be sure to include a **description of the setting and the three doors in your introduction**, then refer to the questions about each door to write a **paragraph for each door**. **In your conclusion, leave the place of the three doors and reflect on how examining them has changed your view of yourself.**
