Dear Northwood Neighbors,

Thank you to all who attended, or followed online, the Northwood Modernization project groundbreaking on June 4th. It was an inspiring event that marked a historic milestone for District 112. Now that summer is well underway, you will begin to see an increase in the pace and the scope of demolition and construction activity in the neighborhood at Northwood.

It has always been our goal to complete this project with the least amount of interruption to your daily lives and to stay in communication with you throughout this process. Below is a timeline of our projected upcoming dates related to the Northwood Modernization project:

Thursday, 7/11/19 – Electrical disconnects begin at the main panel.

Wednesday, 7/17 – Construction fence delivery and set-up. Mechanical and plumbing disconnects, cutting, capping and make it safe.

Thursday, 7/18 – Trailer delivery and set-up. Exploratory excavation at the Heritage Oak Tree and storm sewer line – to be determined.

Monday, 7/22 – ComEd begins the installation of the shielding over the high voltage line along the west property line. Demolition of the northeast corner of the building begins (this is based on preliminary investigation).

We plan to update our Long-Range Planning Web portal (www.nssd112.org/Long-RangePlanning) to have an up-to-date construction site. Construction and modernization will likely continue in some form through December 2020. Northwood Middle School will open in 2021.
