<u>Minor (Tier 1 Behaviors)</u>	<u>Major (Tier 2 Behaviors)</u>
Inappropriate Language: Disruptive language not suited for school use	Profanity: Use of obscene or foul language including swearing and slurs *7:190 Student Discipline
Inappropriate Touching: Not keeping hands, feet, etc to oneself	Physical Aggression: Intentional use of force against another including inappropriate contact and throwing of objects for the purpose of causing harm *7:190 Student Discipline
Noncompliance: Not following directions as they are intended	Defiance: Intentionally ignoring a staff delivered directive or knowingly breaking a school rule after being redirected *7:190 Definition of Gross Disobedience and Misconduct
Disruption: A disorderly verbal or non-verbal outburst causing interruption to the learning environment	Harassment: Verbal, emotional, physical or cyber-related behavior intended to disturb, upset, embarrass, or harm someone else *7:20 Harassment of Students Prohibited
Property Misuse: Not handling school or someone's property in a protective way, as it is intended or allowed to be used. Cell phones and <u>other electronic devices</u> must be turned off, kept in backpacks, and remain in lockers while school is in session. *7:190 Student Discipline	Bullying: Extreme verbal behavior, cyber behavior, or any physical behavior set forth to intimidate a person to make them do something or make them feel uncomfortable *7:180 Preventing Bullying
Dress Code: Not following guidelines for respectful dress at school *7:160 Student Appearance	Truancy: Excessively missing school as determined by the truancy officer *7:70 Attendance and Truancy
Unexcused Tardy: Arriving to school after the morning bell without an acceptable excuse	Vandalism: Intentional and malicious destruction of the property of others causing financial loss *7:190 Student Discipline
Lying: Deliberate act of hiding or changing the truth	Stealing: Intentional taking of another person's property without that person's permission *7:190 Student Discipline
Cheating: Copying answers from someone else or using resources for answers when not approved by a staff member *7:190 Student Discipline	Weapons: Possession of a knife, gun, ammunition or anything associated with causing harm towards another person *7:190 Mandatory Expulsion for Bringing Weapons to School
Unsafe Behavior: Activity that could be harmful to oneself or others *7:190 Student Discipline	Third Minor: Student has received third minor for repeated behavior
