## **NORTH SHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT 112 NAMES SUPERINTENDENT'S LONG-RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE MEMBERS**

Highland Park, Highwood and Fort Sheridan, IL – Tonight North Shore School District 112 (NSSD112) announced members of the Superintendent's Long-Range Planning Committee (LRPC), which includes administrators, teachers, district architect, construction manager, local governments, and citizen representatives from the north, south, west, and central areas of the district.

The charge of the committee will be to aid Superintendent Dr. Michael Lubelfeld as he prepares to make recommendations to the Board of Education for the future configuration of District 112 schools. The first meeting of the group will be on Saturday, July 28 starting at 8 a.m. and will be live streamed at [www.nssd112.org/meetings](http://www.nssd112.org/meetings).

“For too long, District 112 has wrestled with what the long-term path forward should be for the configuration of our schools. It's now time to act,” said Dr. Mike Lubelfeld NSSD112 Superintendent of Schools. “This committee will stand on the foundation of previous community driven efforts and hundreds of viewpoints collected through our community engagement process called Thought Exchange. The committee will be charged with nothing less than helping the administration and Board of Education reimagine education and return excellence to District 112.”

On July 15, NSSD112 concluded a community engagement process using a system called Thought Exchange, which asked stakeholders to share thoughts and rate other ideas from fellow stakeholders on the subject of school configuration. The process included 913 participants who shared 1081 thoughts and submitted more than 50,000 ratings. In addition to this data, The LRPC will also analyze data and feedback generated during past committee processes including the Superintendent’s Citizen Finance and Facilities Advisory Committee and the Reconfiguration 2.0 Team.

The first meeting of the LRPC will be on Saturday July 28 from 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. with two additional meetings scheduled for August and September. All meetings of the LRPC will be live streamed.
