Assisting Residents to Enroll for Health Insurance

Moraine Township has volunteer Navigators who have completed more than 40 hours of training and passed a criminal background check to help residents enroll for insurance under the Affordable Care Act.

Food Insecurity is Growing in our Community

Moraine Township Food Pantry usage increased almost 70% between June and October, 2013. A staggering 27.5% of our School District 112 students qualify for the low-income federal free and reduced lunch program. When residents visit our pantry, in addition to bags of dried food and canned goods, we also provide frozen meat. Fresh produce is offered when possible.
